


# **"PETER IS RESTORED"**

## **JOHN 21:1-25**



### **Across**

- 2 The result of Peter's love for Jesus would be his feeding Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_ (21:15).  
 4 This is the name of the unnamed disciple, whom Jesus loved and who authored this gospel.  
 6 Jesus invited the disciples to "Come and have \_\_\_\_\_." (21:12)

 11 Jesus once again calls out to Peter to "\_\_\_\_\_ me!", reinstating Peter as a disciple (21:19).

13. When have you compared yourself with someone else and wondered why his or her life was the way it was? How did that affect your desire to do what you were supposed to do?
14. If you were writing a book about Jesus’ work in your life, what would be some of the chapter titles? What chapters might you leave out?
