4. Why did Paul regret having sent a harsher letter to the Corinthian church? Do you wish we had that letter or are you glad that it was lost?


5. Have you ever felt anger (perhaps righteous anger) at a person or party? Did you deal with it in a healthy or unhealthy way? How so?
