

## "DANIEL'S VISION OF FOUR BEASTS: PART 2"

1.	When you think about the future, what kind of emotions do you feel? Anxiety? Hope?
2.	Jesus takes Daniel's royal "Son of Man" title as his own, but fuses it with a suffering motif (see Isaiah 53). What aspect of Christ and His kingdom, then, is Daniel predicting in verses 13-14? How does this compare to the other four kingdoms?
3.	What is distinctive about the fourth beast? What do you make of the ten horns (see "ten toes" in 2:41-42)? And the "little horn" with the big mouth? (Does it imply a man, government, a coalition of states, an ideology?
4.	How does the Antichrist seem to come into power? What are the main characteristics of him given in Daniel's vision.
5.	What picture does the "Ancient of Days" bring to mind: Wisdom or senility? Venerability or vulnerability? Sentimental softy or moral purity? Why?
6.	What do you think is implied by "the books were opened" (v.10): Books of Remembrance? Tablets of Fate? Or what? Does your answer say more about God's control, or human freedom?
7.	How does Daniel convey transcendent and earthly aspects of God (vv.9-14). What is the coming kingdom and its heavenly leader like?
8.	Pretend you are playing the "Pictionary" game: Take a minute to draw the scene in verses 13-14. What does this emphasize to you about Jesus Christ? Why is it significant to you that He is like this?
9.	How was this passage in Daniel meant to convey hope to Israel? How did it do so? Why did they need this message at this particular time? How can it bring hope to you and me as we await the second coming of the Son of Man?
