
## "BY THE LIGHT OF A STAR"

3.	CONSIDER (vv. 9-12): What can we learn from the fact that God used the wise men's practice of astrology to lead them to Jesus? What can we learn from God's use of pagan priests to supply the financial needs of Jesus's family?
4.	CONSIDER (vv. 13-18): How do these verses reflect God's sovereignty? What was Matthew's purpose in continually connecting Jesus's story with prophecies from the Old Testament?
5.	CONSIDER (vv. 19-23): How did Jesus's journey as a child parallel that of the Jews as a people? APPLY: How has your life been impacted by the events described in this chapter? What aspects of your life or lifestyle is God asking you to change?
6.	DIG DEEPER (vv. 1-2): Read Genesis 12:1-3 to learn about God's promise to Jesus's ancestor Abraham. How does the appearance of these "wise men from the east" represent a partial fulfillment of that promise?
