8. What passages in the Bible refute the idea of children being punished for the sins of their fathers?

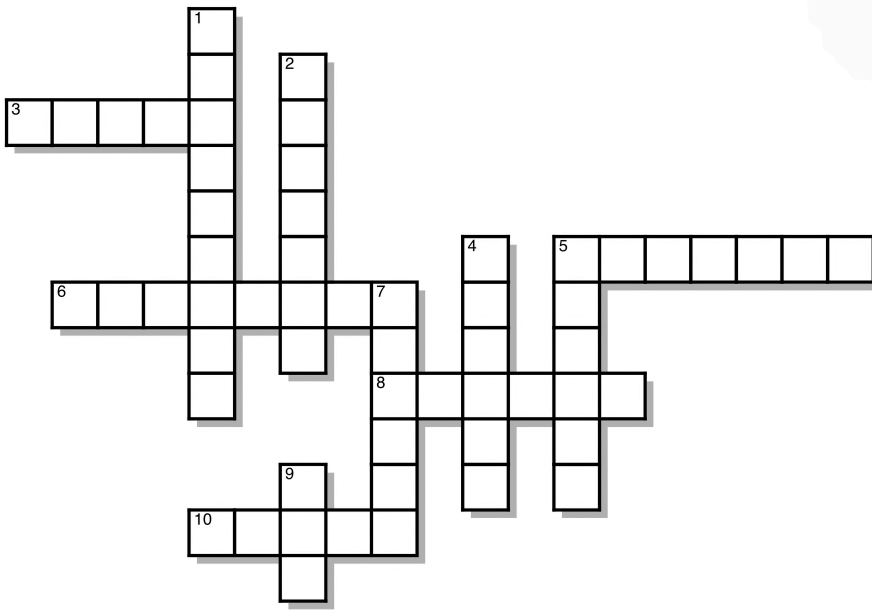
9. How does Jesus serve as our substitute and take on the guilt of our sins?
