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4. What does it mean for a disciple of Christ to carry their cross and lose their life for His sake? How does this compare to the idea of imitating Christ's suffering and death?  

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5. How is Paul's call to imitate him (1 Corinthians 11:1) not contradictory to imitating Christ? What can we learn from Paul's example of being a walking New Testament?  

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6. Reflect on the statement: "People, in seeking to discover who Jesus is, look to us, those who call themselves His disciples." How does this challenge you to live as a faithful disciple?  

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7. In what ways was Martha practicing hospitality when Jesus visited her home? How did her anxiety and busyness become a hindrance to her discipleship?  

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8. How does Jesus' response to Martha reveal the importance of prioritizing time with Him over other activities? Why is it important for us to "sit at His feet" in our discipleship journey?  

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9. How do the examples of the Good Samaritan and Mary and Martha provide a balance between loving God and loving our neighbors? Why is loving God the foundation for loving others?  

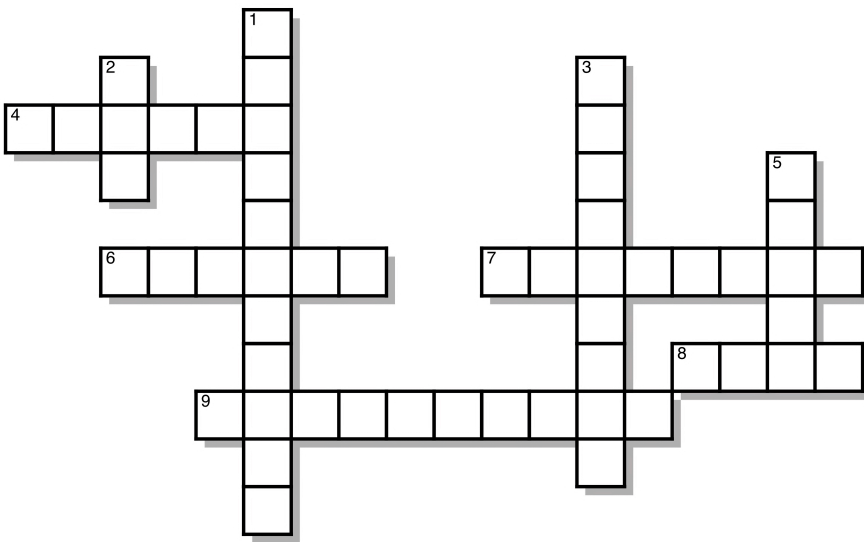
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10. Reflect on the challenge to read the Gospels regularly and even memorize them. How can these practices help you become more like Jesus in your everyday life?
