8. How can believers effectively balance sharing the gospel with demonstrating love through actions?  

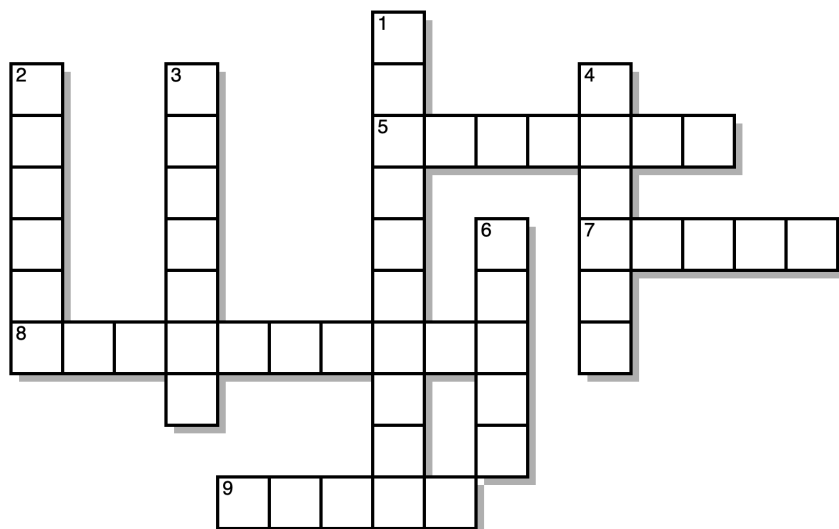
