

"THE POWER OF CHRIST'S RESURRECTION"

- 1. What time do you normally have to get up in the morning? How about on a day off?
- 2. Given what all these women have experienced in the last few days (19:37ff; 23:26-49, 55), how would they feel as they prepare to go to the tomb? When they find it empty? When the two men spoke to them?
- 3. Why wouldn't the Eleven believe them? What must be going through Peter's mind?
- 4. Eavesdrop on the two disciples on the road to Emmaus: What things are they likely talking about as they walk (see vv. 19-24)? What tones of voice do you hear? What hopes are dashed? What plans might they be making? How do they react to the "stranger"?
- 5. From your knowledge of OT prophecy and law, what passages might "the stranger" have discussed with them in verses 25-27? Why did Jesus do this roundabout Bible study rather than just reveal his identity immediately and directly?
- 6. How does the time at dinner open their eyes? What happens to Jesus when they recognize him? Why do you think he leaves?
- 7. What has happened to the other disciples that has caused them to change their minds from verse 11? Why a special appearance to Peter? What expectations must they have now (see also Ac 1:6)?
- 8. How is "peace be with you" a good summary of the gospel?
- 9. Why are the disciples having such difficulty believing: (a) Not using their eyes? (b) Not enough evidence? (c) Not enough faith? (d) Too much joy? Why was it necessary for them to see that Jesus was not a ghost?
- 10. Why should Jesus' followers have anticipated the resurrection rather than expressing surprise and doubt? What helps them to believe?
- 11. Which evidence for the resurrection do you find most convincing? Why?
- 12. What task does Jesus give the disciples? With what promise? How must they have felt?
- 13. How would you live differently if Jesus was not currently reigning in heaven, but was only another noble martyr? Why?
- 14. In light of your circumstances, where is the "mission field" Jesus has called you to? Who are some of the people in that "field"? How can you be a witness to them by your life? By your words?
