
"ROBED WITH FAVOR AND INTEGRITY"

8.	Does Potiphar buy his wife's story "hook, line and sinker"? Why or why not? If so, why doesn't Joseph receive the prescribed death penalty for adulterers?
9.	When might you be more tempted to sexual indiscretion and why: (a) When left alone with an attractive member of the opposite sex? (b) When in the company of others who are breaking all the rules? (c) In a foreign culture, where you don't know all the rules and cultural trappings? (d) On your way to the top, when you feel invincible?
